Guidelines for Ranking and Classifying Treatises

08.27.2014 Ratified at the 1st College Affairs Meeting of academic year 2014

Purpose

These Guidelines for Ranking and Classifying Treatises are stipulated to provide colleagues participating in Engineering-related performance awards with objective, impartial and consistent standards for grading research achievements and to encourage College of Engineering colleagues to strive for higher levels of academic quality.

Contents

Guidelines	Grades
A SCI or SSCI journal in Taiwan or overseas with a comprehensive review mechanism.	Major international journal (Class A)
An EI or TSSCI journal in Taiwan or overseas that is not on the SCI or SSCI but has a comprehensive review mechanism (excluding EI journals that including the word <i>Proceedings</i> in the journal name).	General international journal (Class B)
A Taiwanese journal not on the SCI, EI, SSCI, or TSSCI but with a comprehensive review mechanism and has a publishing schedule (excepting journals released by major Taiwanese colleges and universities). The journal's publications cannot contain any commercial advertisements.	Domestic journal (Class C)
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An informative publication (such as <i>Science Development</i>) released by a government agency or nonprofit corporation or foundation (such as the National Science and Technology Council, the Industrial Technology Research Institute, the National Chung-Shan Institute of Science and Technology, or the National Atomic Research Institute). 2. An informative publication released by a dedicated society or association in Taiwan or overseas. 3. A journal released by a major college or university in Taiwan. 	Magazine articles

<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. An article in a publication with commercial advertisements or a commissioned article (such as in <i>Chemical Engineering</i>, <i>Mechanical Engineering</i>, or <i>Science Monthly</i>).2. An informative article that the author was invited to write or that did not undergo a substantive review process (such as <i>Engineering & Technology Bulletin</i> or <i>Science Monthly</i>).	Other articles
