Regulations on Subsidies for Google Cloud Platform Certifications

07.18.2023 Approved at the 6th College Affairs Meeting of academic year 2022

- Article 1 These regulations are stipulated by the College of Engineering to encourage its faculty and students to obtain Google Cloud Platform (GCP) certification.
- Article 2 Subsidies are limited to the faculty and current students of Yuan Ze University. The application process and awards are as follows:

A. Student subsidies:

- 1. Fill out the YZU GCP Certification Subsidy Application Form (Student Version) and attach a copy of the Google Cloud Skill Boost (GCSB) Profile with the GCP badge.
- 2. Subsidy amounts: The amount for having completed the GCSB Google Cloud Computing Foundations courses is NT \$1,000, the amount for having completed the Cloud Digital Leader certification is NT \$3,000, and the amount for being certified as an Associate Cloud Engineer is NT \$5,000.

B. Faculty subsidies:

- 1. Fill out the YZU GCP Certification Subsidy Application Form (Faculty Version) and attach a copy of the certificate.
- 2. Subsidy amounts: The subsidy shall be the amount of the registration fee and disbursed in accordance with actual expenses.
- Article 3 These subsidies are funded by the Ministry of Education's Higher Education SPROUT Project and the YZU College of Engineering; the application process, number of subsidies granted, and amounts shall be otherwise announced by the College in accordance with the annual budget.
- Article 4 Subsidy applicants should submit their application and supporting documents to the College of Engineering no later than October 31 of the year they were certified; applications will not be processed if they are overdue or the budget has been exhausted.
- Article 5 These regulations and their amendments shall be promulgated following approval by the College Affairs Meeting.
